

## CROSSING GUTTERS

(a) No person or persons shall drive any team, or cause to be driven, any wheeled vehicle, or other vehicle, across or over any curbstone or sidewalk in the Town of Stellarton, except in places where suitable bridges and crossings are provided and hereinafter directed.

(b) Any owner or owners of property where asphalt or concrete sidewalks have been or are being or hereinafter may be laid or made within the Town of Stellarton, who are or may be desirous of obtaining leave, or who may now claim the right to cross the said sidewalk with trucks or other vehicles as aforesaid, shall provide at his or their own proper costs and charges, stone or other permanent crossings of such width and material as may be required, and a suitable bridge across the gutter of such pattern as may be approved by the Street Committee or an officer duly appointed by the Town, and where any such owner or owners shall fail to provide the said crossing and bridge as hereinbefore directed, the Town Council is hereby authorized to provide and furnish the same as it sees fit, and the price of same paid therefor shall be recovered against the owner or owners in the name of the Town as any debt due the Town, and where more than one owner or proprietor is interested in, or make use of such crossing each owner or proprietor shall be severally liable to the Town for the whole amount recoverable under this By-Law.

(c) Any person violating paragraph "A" of this By-Law shall be subject to a penalty not exceeding the sum of Twenty Dollars for each offence, to be enforced by conviction before the Stipendiary Magistrate of the Town of Stellarton, and in default of payment of any fine imposed, shall be liable to imprisonment for a period not exceeding Sixty Days.
