




At a regular meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Stellarton held on Tuesday the 14th day of December A. D. 1948, the following By-Law was passed unanimously by the said Town Council, and it was decided to have the same forwarded to the Department of Municipal Affairs for approval and certification.

BY-LAW RESPECTING CURFEWS

1. An alarm ordinarily known as the Fire Alarm shall be sounded twice at nine o'clock each evening, and shall be known as "The Curfew Alarm".
2. No boy or girl under the age of fifteen years shall be, or remain on, or in, any street or public place of the Town of Stellarton after the said Curfew Alarm has sounded, unless accompanied by one of his or her parents or guardians or some adult person authorized for such purpose by one of his or her parents or guardians.
3. Any such child found on or in any such street or public place unaccompanied as aforesaid in the night time, twenty minutes after the Curfew Alarm has sounded between the hours of nine twenty P. M. and six A. M. the following morning, after being notified by a policeman or constable not to loaf, walk, or be on any such street or in any such public place after the said Alarm has so sounded, may be taken in charge by any policeman or constable, and taken to his or her home, and his or her parents warned by such policeman or constable that if the offence is repeated they shall be liable to the penalties hereinafter mentioned.
4. The parents or guardians of any such child, who, after such warning, contravenes the provisions of this By-Law, shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding Five Dollars and in default of payment, to imprisonment for a period not exceeding Ten days.
5. It shall be the duty of the Chief of Police and his assistants to see that these By-Laws or regulations are enforced.
