

BY-LAW RESPECTING ELECTRICIANS

BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Stellarton, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the Towns Incorporation Act, do hereby make and enact the following By-law:

1. No person shall engage in the business of an electrical contractor, electrician, wireman, or engage in wiring, or the repair of existing wiring, in dwellings, commercial establishments, garages, churches or public buildings in the Town of Stellarton without first having been registered and licensed by the Town Council of the Town of Stellarton. The fee for such license shall be and annual amount of Twenty-five Dollars.

2. No such license shall issue to such person unless he holds a Certificate of Qualification, granted in conformity with the General Regulations made by the Lieutenant Governor in Council under authority of Chapter 11 of the Revised Statutes of Nova Scotia 1954, being the "apprenticeship Act", and such license shall automatically be suspended or cancelled upon the suspension or cancellation of such Certificate of qualification, under the terms of such Act and regulations, and may only be re-issued upon proof of reinstatement of the Certificate of Qualification.

3. No person shall knowingly permit or engage any unlicensed person, as required by Section 1 hereof, to do or perform any of the Acts therein mentioned, on any premises owned or occupied by him.

4. No person who holds a Certificate of Qualification, as referred to in Paragraph 2 hereof, and has paid a license fee to any City, Town or Municipality in this Province, shall be liable to pay a license fee in the Town of Stellarton.

5. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this By-law shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty of not more than \$50.00 and in default of payment to imprisonment for the term of not more than 30 days.
