

LICENSES

1. Every license mentioned in this By-Law shall be granted on the recommendation of the Committee on Police and Licenses (hereinafter called the Committee) and shall be signed and issued by the Clerk and shall be in force until the first day of March next succeeding the day in which the same is issued.

2. Every license shall state the date when the same expires and the occupation or privilege authorized or granted and any terms or conditions imposed by the Committee.

3. Every day during which any contravention or failure to comply with any requirement of this By-law continues shall constitute a fresh offence.

4. In any action, prosecution, or other proceeding in respect to any contravention or failure to comply with any requirement of this By-Law it shall not be necessary for the plaintiff, prosecutor or other party having the conduct of the proceedings to prove that the defendant or person accused does not hold a license, but the burden of proving the holding of a license shall be upon the defendant or person accused.

5. Any license may at any time for any contravention of or failure to comply with the conditions of the same, and whether a penalty has been imposed for such contravention or failure or not be revoked by the Committee. The fact that the license is liable to such revocation shall be stated in the license.
