Pension By-Law

Be it enacted by the Town Council of the Town of Stellarton as follows: Pursuant to Subsection (7) of Section 243 of the Towns' Act, being Chapter 293 of the Revised Statutes of Nova Scotia, 1954, as amended by Section 9 of Chapter 46 of the Acts of Nova Scotia, 1964, a pension of Sixty-five Dollars (\$ 65.00) per month, to commence on the 15th day of January A. D., 1967, be paid by the Town of Stellarton to Lester R. McCully during the remainder of his natural life.

PENSION BY-LAW

BE it enacted by the Town Council of the Town of Stellarton as follows: Pursuant to Subsection (12) of Section 221 of the Towns' Act, being Chapter 309 of the Revised Statutes of Nova Scotia, 1967, and amendments thereto, it is hereby provided that a pension of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) per month, be paid by the Town of Stellarton, out of the current revenues of the Town, to Cecil L. Martin, Chief of Police for the Town of Stellarton, commencing June 15th, A.D., 1979, the date of his retirement, for and during the remainder of his natural life.
