

No person shall keep or maintain any pigsty, or stable or byre, wherein pigs, horses, or cattle, are kept, within the Town of Stellarton, without the permission of the Town Council of the Town first being had and obtained.

Every person who contravenes the foregoing by-law shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding Twenty Dollars, and in default of payment to imprisonment for a period not exceeding Thirty days.
