

PUBLIC PROPERTY

1. The Council shall have full power to manage the real estate of the Town, and to lease the same for any term, not exceeding fifteen years, and on such conditions as they shall see fit.
2. All leases and deeds shall be under the Town Seal, signed by the Mayor and countersigned by the Town Clerk.
3. Any person or persons destroying, injuring or defacing any bridge, or other public property of the Town, or property under the control of the Town, or digging up, or removing any of the soil or stones on the common or other public property, shall be liable to a penalty of not less than Two, or more than Forty Dollars, and in default of payment shall be sentenced to confinement in the lock-up or jail for a period not less than three or more than thirty days.

STELLARTON TRACK AND FIELD BY-LAW

1. It shall be unlawful for any person to use or trespass upon the area provided for track and field facilities located on the George Saunders Elementary School grounds, in the Town of Stellarton, with a horse, motorized go-cart, motorcycle, bicycle or motor vehicle except for the purpose of maintaining the said facilities
2. Every person who violates this by-law shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding \$100.00, and in default of payment to imprisonment for a period not exceeding thirty days.
