

SLAUGHTER HOUSES

1. No person or persons or corporate body shall erect, maintain, continue, use or employ any slaughter house or building, or any yard or other place or premises for the purpose of killing therein within the limits of the Town of Stellarton.

2. No butcher or other person shall kill, slaughter any beeves, cows, calves, sheep, swine or other animals within the limits of the Town of Stellarton.

3. There shall be no accumulation of manure or filth of any description in or about any butcher shop within the Town of Stellarton, but all such butcher shops and the yards connected therewith shall at all times be kept clean by the respective owner or occupiers thereof.

4. All sheds, stables, pens, yards and other enclosures where horses, cows, pigs, or other animals are kept, housed or penned, shall be properly constructed and shall be kept drained and cleaned to the satisfaction of the Sanitary Inspectors, to whom such sheds, stables, pens, yards or other enclosures shall at any hour during the daytime be open for inspection.

5. Any person or persons, or body corporate, guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this Chapter, shall, upon conviction before the Stipendiary Magistrate, forfeit and pay at the discretion of the said Magistrate a penalty not exceeding the sum of Twenty Dollars for each offence, exclusive of costs, and in default of payment, thereof, it shall and may be lawful for the said Stipendiary Magistrate to commit the offender or offenders to the common gaol or lock-up in the Town of Stellarton, for a period of Thirty Days, unless the said penalty and costs be sooner paid.
