

STORAGE OF OIL, ETC.

1. No person shall have at any time above ground in any building more than fifteen gallons of Benzine, Naptha or Gasoline, unless the same is contained in a steel barrel, in which case they may have not exceeding fifty gallons.

2. No person shall have at any time above ground in any building within one hundred feet of any other building more than six barrels of Petroleum or other inflammable oil.

3. No person shall keep or have in any place within 100 feet of any other building any greater quantity of the petroleum products above mentioned than allowed under Sec. 1 and 2 of these By-Laws, unless said Petroleum products are stored in a tank which is buried in the earth, and all of the said tank, excepting the pipes leading to the surface is covered with earth or concrete to the satisfaction of the Town Engineer.

4. No person shall at any time have in any place or building more than ten empty coal oil barrels which have contained illuminating oil.

5. No explosive or combustible substance or combustible fluid shall be kept under a stairway or in any other place so as to obstruct or render egress dangerous in case of fire.

6. Every person who contravenes or fails to comply with any of the foregoing provisions in respect to storage or use of inflammable substances and fluids shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding Forty Dollars, and in default of payment to imprisonment not exceeding Sixty Days.
