

THE LOCK-UP

1. The Council shall continue to maintain the Lock-up at present established in the Town, or such other Lock-up house in lieu thereof, or in addition thereto, as it determines, and shall, as may be necessary from time to time appoint a keeper thereof.

2. The Keeper of the Lock-up shall:—

(a) keep the cells in such Lock-up comfortable and in a sanitary condition;

(b) provide, at the expense of the Town, meals for the prisoners in the Lock-up; and

(c) assist the Police Officer when he arrives at the Lock-up with a prisoner.

3. The Committee on Police and Licenses may, subject to the approval of the Council, from time to time make, amend, or repeal rules for the regulation of the keeper of the Lock-up.
