

TOWN SOLICITOR

1. The Town Solicitor shall:—

(a) give legal advice and assistance to the Mayor and Councillors and the Town Officials in the performance of the duties of their respective offices;

(b) attend all meetings of the Council and of any committee when required so to do;

(c) draft and revise all legal documents required by the Town;

(d) act as Solicitor and Counsel for the Town in all actions in which the Town is a party, or which are conducted in behalf of, or on the part of the Town;

(e) take charge of and manage all the legal business connected with the affairs of the town;

(f) attend before any committee of the legislature on behalf of the Town, when the Council so directs.
