

ANTI-NOISE BY-LAW

RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Stellarton, that the following By-law be and the same is hereby enacted and that the Clerk be and is hereby instructed to forward same to the Minister of Municipal Affairs with the request for his approval thereof:

1. THAT the Prevention of Disorder and Impropriety By-Law be amended by inserting immediately after Section 2 (i) the following:

Section (j)

No person, in any private dwelling or house, or multi-residence, whether or not he is the lawful owner of the private dwelling, house, or multi-residence, shall cause, allow or permit the use or operation of a public address system, phonograph, gramophone, radio, or other device or apparatus, whether operated electrically, mechanically or in any other way whatsoever, which reproduces, amplifies, emits, or transmits sounds which are capable of being heard on any street, public place, building, or any other part of a multi-residence used wholly or in part as a residence, at such hours or times as to unnecessarily or unreasonably interfere with the enjoyment by other persons of said street, public place, building, or multi-residence.

(2) For the purposes of this By-law, it shall be deemed unnecessary and unreasonable interference with the enjoyment of said street, public place, building, or multi-residence, if such sounds are audible under normal conditions on any street, public place, or building used wholly or partly as a residence, or in any other part of a multi-residence, used as a residence.
