



SUMMER EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES

SPORT & RECREATION MAINTENANCE

The Town of Stellarton is accepting applications from youth for summer employment to assist with the maintenance of the sport and recreational facilities in Stellarton. Applicants must be between the ages of 16-30.

Duties include but are not limited to: Marking sport fields, mowing, minor carpentry, garbage clean up, safety inspections, special event support and trail maintenance. This job is physically demanding, requires heavy lifting, the ability to work outdoors in all types of weather and on occasion, be available to work flexible hours. Basic First Aid and WHMIS will be considered assets.

Summer students are required to drive town vehicles on occasion in order to complete their duties. Students must possess a valid driver's license.

GROUNDS MAINTENANCE WORKER

The Town of Stellarton is accepting applications from students for summer employment to assist with landscape maintenance and related duties consistent with Communities in Bloom mandate.

Duties include but are not limited to: Installation of floral displays and shrubs, applying topsoil and mulch to beds, mowing, painting, litter pick up, and landscaping. This job is physically demanding, requires heavy lifting, the ability to work outdoors in all types of weather and on occasion, be available to work flexible hours. Basic First Aid and WHMIS will be considered assets.

Summer students are required to drive town vehicles on occasion in order to complete their duties. Students must possess a valid driver's license.

DAY CAMP COUNSELOR
