

The By-Laws of the Town of Stellarton are hereby amended as follows; in accordance with Chapter 42, Acts of 1942:

By substituting for Section 2 of the said By-Laws respecting Poll Tax the following Section.

" 2. Such as are not rated upon any amount, the sum of Ten Dollars, providing that if the said Poll Tax is paid on or before the 1st day of May in any year, the sum of Eight Dollars only shall be payable."




