

BILL POSTERS—DEFINITIONS

1. In these By-Laws:

(a) The expression "Bill Poster" means every person who posts in any public place by means of pasting, tacking, painting, or otherwise, or who distributes upon the street any advertising matter, bills, posters, pictures or any other thing, matter or device whatever, advertising the business or goods of any firm, person or corporation, or any entertainment, but does not mean a sign painter, painting any sign for a shop, office or building, or a Sheriff or other officer of the law, posting any notice by law required to be posted by him.

(b) The expression "Post Bills or Placards" means the carrying on of the business or occupation of a bill poster as defined in clause "a" hereof.

(c) The expression "Bill or Placard" means any such advertising matter as defined in clause "a" whether printed or painted or otherwise.

(d) The word "Billboard" means a boarding, sign, fence, building, frame or construction of wood, metal or other material, erected, maintained or used for the display of advertising matter, bills or placards in a public place, the subject matter of which does not relate to the property on which said billboard or boarding is placed.
