

## BOUNDARIES OF WARDS

1. The Town of Stellarton shall be divided into three Wards as follows:

Ward Number One, beginning at a point on the west side of the East River, and extending westerly along the original south line of lands of John McIntosh to Bear Brook; thence along the east side of Bear Brook to Acadia Avenue; thence easterly along Acadia Avenue to the East River; and thence southerly along the East River to the place of beginning.

Ward Number Two, beginning at the East River in a line with Acadia Avenue and extending westerly along Acadia Avenue to Bear Brook; thence northerly along the east side of Bear Brook to the old Middle River road; thence easterly along the old Middle River road and Bridge Street to the East River; thence southerly along the East River, to the place of beginning.

Ward Number Three, beginning at the East River, and extending westerly along Bridge Street and the old Middle River road to Bear Brook; thence northerly along Bear Brook to the Middle River road; thence easterly along the south side of Middle River road and the original north boundary line of the Town of Stellarton until it comes to the East River; thence southerly along the East River until it comes to the place of beginning.

2. The Town shall be governed by a Council, to consist of a Mayor and six Councillors, residents of the Town, to be elected by the ratepayers thereof, as provided by "The Town's Incorporation Act."

Two Councillors to hold office for two years shall be elected by each Ward, and a Mayor to hold office for two years by all Wards.
