

In accordance with Bill Number 129 of the Act of Nova Scotia, 1936, amending Chapter 162, Revised Statutes of Nova Scotia, 1923, "The Theatres, Cinematographs and Amusements Act", and Chapter 83, Revised Statutes, 1923, "The Municipal Act", and Chapter 84, Revised Statutes, 1923, "The Towns' Incorporation Act" the Town of Stellarton hereby applies to the Governor-in-Council to repeal the ~~14444~~ by-law in force in said Town of Stellarton regarding "Circuses" and substitute the following By Law therefore:-

"Circuses and Other Itinerant Amusement Performances".

"Every person who holds or intends to hold a circus or other itinerant amusement performance within the Town of Stellarton, shall, previous to the opening of such circus or other itinerant amusement performance, first pay to the Town of Stellarton for a license for such circus or other itinerant amusement performance, a sum of not less than fifty dollars and not exceeding two hundred dollars, said license to be granted on the recommendation of the Committee on Police and Licenses, and to be signed and issued by the Town Clerk, and in default of obtaining and paying such license, he shall be liable to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars exclusive of costs, and in default of immediate payment to imprisonment for a period not exceeding sixty days."

I hereby certify that at a regular meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Stellarton, held in the Council Chamber on Tuesday the 9th day of June, A.D. 1936, a motion was unanimously passed to apply to the Governor-in-Council for the passage of the above endorsed by law in accordance with the amendment to "The Theatres and Cinematographs Act" which was passed at the last session of the Legislature.
