

Resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Stellanton that the following By-Law is hereby enacted and that the Clerk forward two duly certified copies to the Minister of Municipal Affairs with a request for his approval hereof:

PARKS BY-LAW

1. In this By-Law:
 - (a) "Park" includes all areas designated by the Town Council of the Town of Stellanton as public park and recreational areas;
 - (b) "Co-Ordinator" is the Parks and Recreational Co-Ordinator as designated by the Town Council and includes the Assistant Co-Ordinator;
 - (c) "Commission" means the Parks and Recreation Commission of the Town of Stellanton.
 - (d) "Vehicle" means every device in, upon or by which any person or property is transported, excepting a baby carriage and a wheel chair.
2. No person while within the confines of a park shall:

ACTS PROHIBITED IN PARKS:

 - (a) Throw or leave any paper, cardboard, food refuse and tins, bottles or glass or any matter of any kind likely to prove offensive, injurious, or unsightly, all such matter shall either be placed in receptacles provided in the Park for that purpose or shall be carried away from the park for disposal by the person having such matter in his possession;

CARRYING WEAPONS:

 - (b) Carry or discharge any fireworks, firearm, airgun, sling-shot, catapult or other weapon or dangerous toy;

THROWING MISSILES:

 - (c) Throw or cast any stone or other missile;

DEFACING GROWTH:

 - (d) Cut, break, bend or in any way injure or deface any turf, tree, shrub, hedge, plant, flower or park ornament;

CLIMBING TREES:

(e) Climb any trees;

DEFACING PROPERTY:

(f) Climb upon, deface, or in any way damage any building wall, fence, gate, sign, bench, exhibit, cage or any ornament.

TOUCHING WIRING, ETC:

(g) Plug, tamper with or in any way damage any plumbing, lighting or other fixture;

FIRE:

(h) Light any fire at any time, except in designated areas.

IGNORING SIGNS:

(i) Walk upon any lawn or garden where signs are posted prohibiting persons from so doing nor ignore any sign or signal erected for the control of pedestrians or vehicle traffic;

ANIMALS AT LARGE:

(j) Permit any livestock or any domestic animal to run at large;

POSTING, NOTICES, SIGNS:

(k) Distribute any handbills or circulars nor post, place or display any placard, notice, paper, advertising device, or publicity matter of any kind without the written consent of the Commission.

MOLESTING OF ANIMALS:

(l) Tease, molest, or injure any mammal, bird or fish, nor throw any substance at or near such creatures in such a way as to cause them alarm or possible injury.

3. LICENSE:

No person shall offer for sale within any park any article of food, drink or merchandise or carry on any business unless such person has received prior written approval of the Commission and has been licensed as required by the Licenses and Permits By-Law, of the Town of Stellarton.

4. *DISORDERLY CONDUCT:*

No person within any park shall use any blasphemous, obscene or vulgar language nor conduct himself or herself in a disorderly or offensive manner or molest or injure any other person or loiter or take up a temporary abode overnight within any park or obstruct the free use and enjoyment of the park by any person.

5. *STRUCTURES IN PARKS:*

No person shall erect, build or locate nor permit the erection, building or locating in any park of any trailer, shelter, or other building or any tent or other shelter without first obtaining the written permission of the Commission.

6. *DIGGING:*

No person other than an authorized agent of the Town shall dig in the earth of any park nor remove any tree or any rock or any other matter that is fixed or growing from within the park.

7. *GAMES EQUIPMENT:*

No person over the age of 16 years shall personally use or play on any playground equipment in any park which is designed for children without the permission of the Commission.

8. *PICNIC AREAS:*

No person or persons shall picnic except in parts of the park designated for that purpose.

9. *VEHICLE PARKING:*

No person shall have, drive or park any vehicle in a Park except in those areas designated for that purpose.

10. No person shall travel in or be upon a park between 10:00 o'clock in the afternoon and 7:00 o'clock in the forenoon without the consent of the Commission.
11. Every person who violates' or fails to comply with the provisions of this by-law shall be liable on conviction to a penalty as provided by the By-law of Penalties for breach of Town of Stellarton By-Laws.




Recommended for approval with amendments.


Departmental Solicitor

The Park Bylaw which was adopted at a meeting of Stellarton Town Council held 11 July, 1983, is approved, pursuant to Section 24 of the Municipal Affairs Act, with the following amendments:

1. Subsection (a) of Section 2 is amended in lines 3 and 4 by deleting the following words "unless expressly authorized by the Town or its designated representative".
2. Subsection (a) of Section 5 is amended in lines 4 and 5 by deleting the following words "without having received the permission of the Town in writing".
3. Subsection (b) of Section 5 is amended by deleting the following ", or in any way foul or pollute any fountain, stream, pool, pond, well or spring".
4. Subsection (a) of Section 7 is amended by deleting in lines 2 and 3 the following words "without the permission of the Town".
5. Subsection (a) of Section 8 is amended in line 2 by inserting immediately after the word "liable" the words "on conviction".

PARK BY-LAW

RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Town of Stellarton, that the following By-law made pursuant to Section 221 (3) Towns Act RSNS 1967, Chapter 309, be and the same is hereby enacted and that the Clerk be and is hereby instructed to forward same to the Minister of Municipal Affairs with the request for his approval thereof:

Definitions:

1. (a) In this By-law unless the content otherwise requires, the expression; "park" means the area known as Allan Park and any other area used and maintained by the Town of Stellarton for the purpose of a park or recreation area.

Closing of Park:

2. (a) No person, except an employee of the Town, shall enter or be in a Park between the hours of 10:00 o'clock in the afternoon and 8:00 o'clock in the forenoon ~~unless expressly authorized by the Town or its designated representative.~~

Travel within Park:

3. (a) No person shall drive an automobile, bicycle, motorcycle, snow-mobile, or any other vehicle within the confines of a Park.

Firearms:

4. (a) No person shall discharge firearms, air guns or use bows and arrows or slingshots or other dangerous weapons within a Park.

Damage to Trees, Shrubs, Etc.

5. (a) No person shall remove earth, sods, or stones, from a Park or cut down or take away or injure any of the trees, shrubs, bushes or plants growing therein or erect any booth, tent or shed, or park any trailer anywhere in a Park ~~without having received the permission of the Town in writing.~~

Rubbish:

6. (a) No person shall deposit rubbish or other articles on any part of a Park.

Fire Protection:

7. (a) No person shall make, light or start or cause to be made, lighted, or started any fire on any land within a Park ~~without the permission of the Town.~~

(b) No person shall leave any fire which he has made, lighted or started or caused to be made, lighted or started without first extinguishing the fire completely.

Penalty:

8. (a) Every person who contravenes or fails to comply with any ^{OR} provision of these By-laws shall for each offense be liable to a penalty as provided for the breach of By-laws of the Town of Stellarton.

- Fire Protection:
6. No person shall make, light or cause to be made, lighted or started any fire on any land within a Park.
- Rubbish:
7. No person shall deposit rubbish or other articles on any part of a Park.
- Penalty:
8. Every person who contravenes or fails to comply with any provision of these By-Laws shall on conviction, for each offence, be liable to a penalty as provided for the breach of By-Laws of the Town of Stellarton.
