### **REGULAR**

The regular monthly meeting of the Stellarton Police Commission was held on December 3, 2015 at 5:00 p.m.

### **PRESENT**

### **AGENDA**

### **MINUTES:**

### **MONTHLY ACTIVITY REPORT**

Discussion was held on several topics: number of impaired operators; number of motor vehicle collisions; 4 way stop at Acadia Foord intersection; traffic light update; citizen concern about noise at the former Scotsburn Dairy location; average speed detected on MacGregor Avenue; location of the moving speed monitor. ### **RENEWAL OF TERM EMPLOYEE**

### **NEW TERM EMPLOYEE**

Chairman Don Taylor, on behalf of the Interview Committee, reported to the Commission with the recommendation that Adam Syer be appointed as the new Term Employee – December 4, 2015 to June 3, 2016 – 6 months term.

On motion Comms. J. Langlois and J. MacLellan it was agreed to accept the recommendation and hire Adam Syer as the new Term Employee, 6 months term. Comms. K. Francis suggested that the Chief bring the new Constables to the next meeting to meet the Stellarton Police Commission and for the Commission Members to meet the new Officers.
